TENNIS RULES

Four (4) tennis courts are available for use by association members. They are located below the clubhouse. The courts have available lighting for evening play.

1. ALL residents must sign-in themselves and their guests before playing on any court. Sign in on clipboard attached to fence.
2. ONE Meadowview resident must be present on each court in use. Be prepared to show your key fob and I.D.
3. REGULATION TENNIS SHOES MUST BE WORN ON THE COURTS AT ALL TIMES. BLACK SOLED SHOES, RUNNING SHOES AND SANDALS ARE **PROHIBITED**.
4. When all courts are in use:
 1. Single players are expected to “double up” with those waiting to play
 2. One set or half hour hitting limit
 3. One court per Member
5. Good sportsmanship and tennis etiquette are to be observed at all times.
6. Be courteous to the neighbors-KEEP NOISE LEVELS DOWN.
7. Special league events approved by the Board, such as tournaments and exhibitions, will have priority of court usage.
8. Tennis lessons can be given to Meadowview residents only (plus one guest). All tennis pros must give a copy of their USTA insurance to the office and have written approval by the Board before giving lessons to members.
